

Application of a request for First aid – during lesson time

- 1. If a pupil requires first aid support the member of staff should request this through Class Charts during lessons.
- 2. All information is logged on Class Charts which informs parents / guardians of the incident
- 3. A member of first aid will respond via Class Charts with further advice/instruction when the request for assistance has been made and will decide on the appropriate actions for the pupil.
- 4. Additional parental / guardian contact is made should the pupil require further medical assistance, as well as emergency first aid, such as the need for an ambulance etc.
- 5. Where the child has sustained a head injury or the use of the Academy's inhaler has been used, additional information will be provided to the parent / guardian in writing.



Application of a request for First aid – during free time

- Member of staff on duty will radio for first aid support.
- First aid trained member of staff will respond to radio call and respond to pupil.
- First aider to log incident on Class Charts any action taken. Triage for further action (call ambulance / parent / guardian).
- Member of staff on duty that witnessed the incident to complete an accident report.
- Serious injuries to be reported to the Health and Safety Executive.

Complaints

If a parent / guardian is unhappy with the way a first aid incident has been dealt with they may address their concerns in writing to the Principal.

Parents whose concerns are unresolved have recourse to the Academy's formal complaints procedure.
