

School Uniform Standards and Expectations

This flyer is designed to clarify our school uniform expectations for all pupils for the coming year. We are publishing this reminder to ensure that parents have plenty of time to make the necessary arrangements for all children to wear full school uniform from August 2019. We are very proud of our uniform as it represents a visible commitment to the values of our school. We appreciate your support with this on a daily basis.

What to Wear

- Formal school shoes
- Black tailored trousers or tailored pencil skirt to the knee
- White shirt tucked in and top button fastened
- Full length tie neck to waistband
- Blazer (a school jumper is optional, not instead of a blazer)
- · One pair of stud earrings & watch allowed

We expect you to ensure shirts are tucked in at all times

We expect you to wear a full-length tie at all times

What Not to Wear

- No excessive make-up neutral and natural tones.
- No overt false eyelashes neutral and natural
- No extreme hair designs or hair colours neutral and natural colours/tones
- No additional jewellery to be worn except that worn for religious observance
- No extreme nail designs and length neutral and natural colours/tones. Must be suitable for PE/DT and other practical lessons – Health & Safety
- No additional ear or facial piercings allowed clear plastic retainers can be worn
