

Stanground Academy - PE Kit Standards and Expectations

We aim to promote Aspirations in PE, forged in a Social responsibility for one another and the community. We will inspire our learners to Progress through purposeful and vigorous participation. Pupils will be instilled with Integrity, which will facilitate Respect towards others, fostering Excellence throughout core and examination PE.

All pupils are required to participate in Physical Education as part of their core curriculum throughout their time in the academy. It is important that each pupil shows excellent standards of work, effort and behaviour in every lesson.

Pupils that are not able to participate in the practical aspect of a lesson must provide a written note or have made contact with the academy via parents/carers regarding their medical condition. These pupils are still expected to bring PE kit and will be fully involved in the learning of the lesson as a leader, coach, referee unless their medical condition prevents this. No Jewellery, watches or bracelets are permitted, long hair must be tied back. Any piercings must be fully removed and stored safely by the pupils.

PE Kit Requirements

- Black polo top and jumper, either plain or with the STA logo on are acceptable. No large sports logos are allowed. No hooded tops or coats.
- Black shorts or tracksuit bottoms. Plain or with the STA logo on are acceptable. Sports leggings are permitted but they must not be of a 'see through' material.
- Plain black 'long' football socks or usual sports/trainer socks (white or black).
- Sports specific trainers no plimsols or 'vans' type trainers.
- Football boots/shin pads are strongly recommended for outdoor use on either the grass or Astroturf surfaces.
- Pupils may also bring extra items of clothing to wear underneath their PE kit on a cold day
 e.g., an extra t-shirt or sports base layers but these must be black in colour.
- Swimming plain black shorts/trunks or a one-piece costume, along with a towel, will all need to be safely stored in a separate PE bag or plastic bag. Swimming hats are compulsory, but goggles are optional.

Forgotten PE kit

- If a pupil forgets their PE kit, then they are expected to wear 'spare' PE kit, that is routinely washed and monitored. The following sanctions apply for not bringing PE kit
 - 1st offence = warning and kit mark logged
 - 2nd offence = Correction on the same day until 3.45pm
 - 3rd offence = Correction on the same day until 4.30pm. Parents/carers contacted.
 - 4th offence = Correction on the same day until 6pm. Placement in IE. Meeting with HOD + Action Plan.
